Michael Foley is an exceptional artist. Not only does he have extraordinary skills as a choreographer, he is also a wonderful mentor and leader. He set the choreographic work *No Angels in my Kamikaze Heaven on* my company in November of 2007. His work with the dancers was memorable. His listening skills, ability to draw the best out of the dancers, and his friendly nature made him a favorite with the dancers and staff. His choreographic work was powerful, intricate and exciting. The work was so successful it became an important part of our repertory. We received funding from the National Dance Project to perform the work at numerous theatres across the country as part of our NewDANCEfest production.
